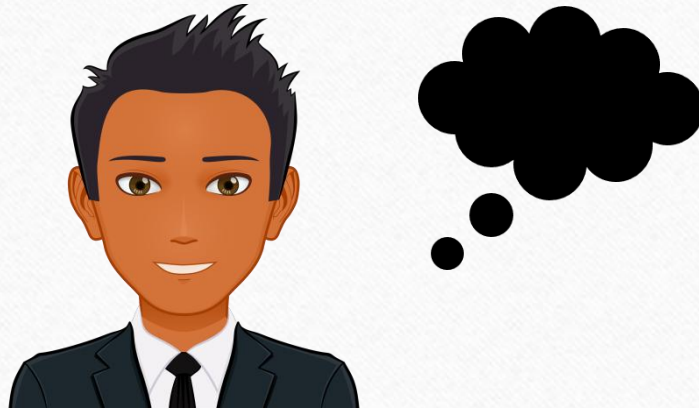
March 21 is the United Nations (UN)

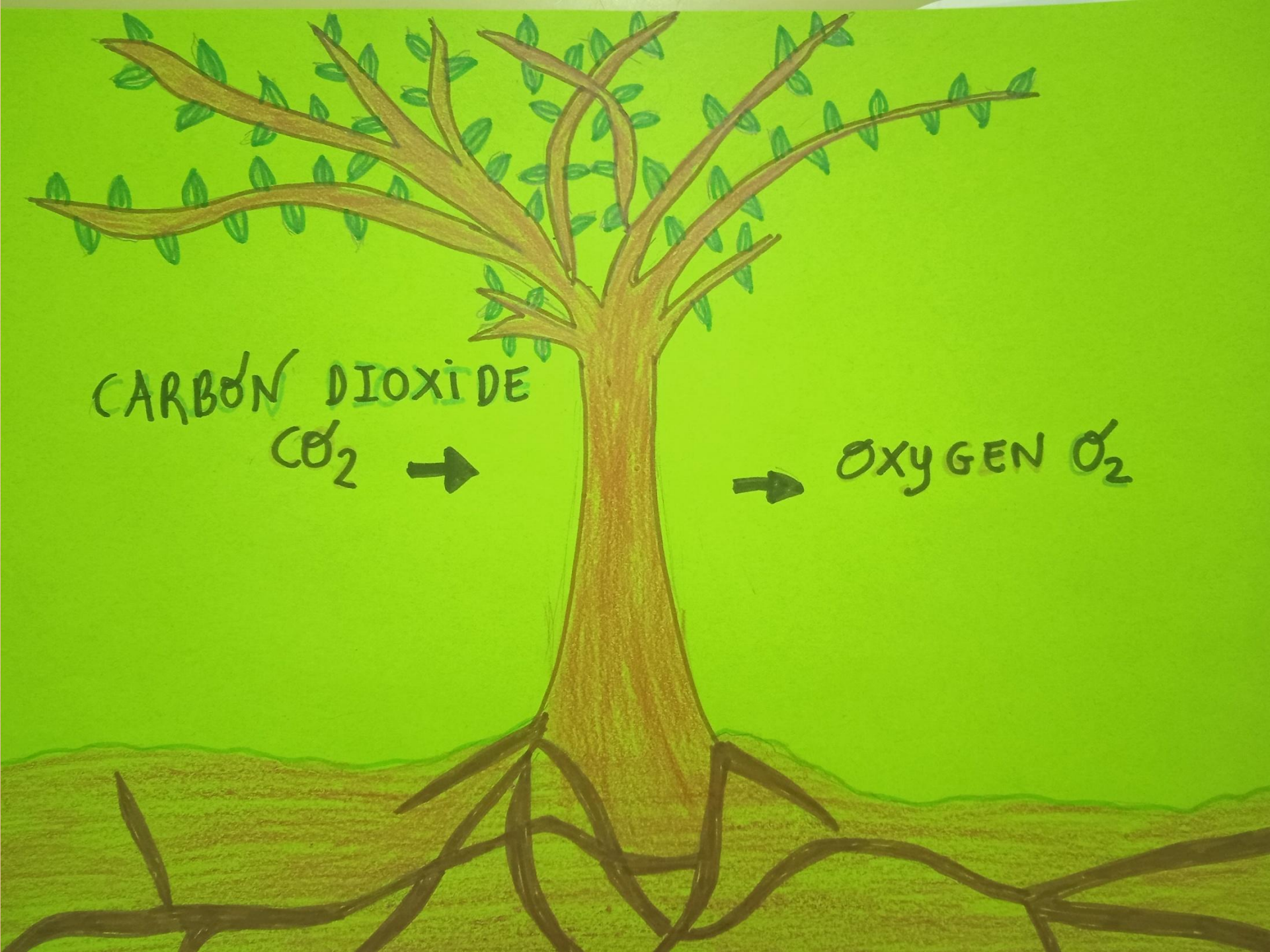
International Day of Forests,

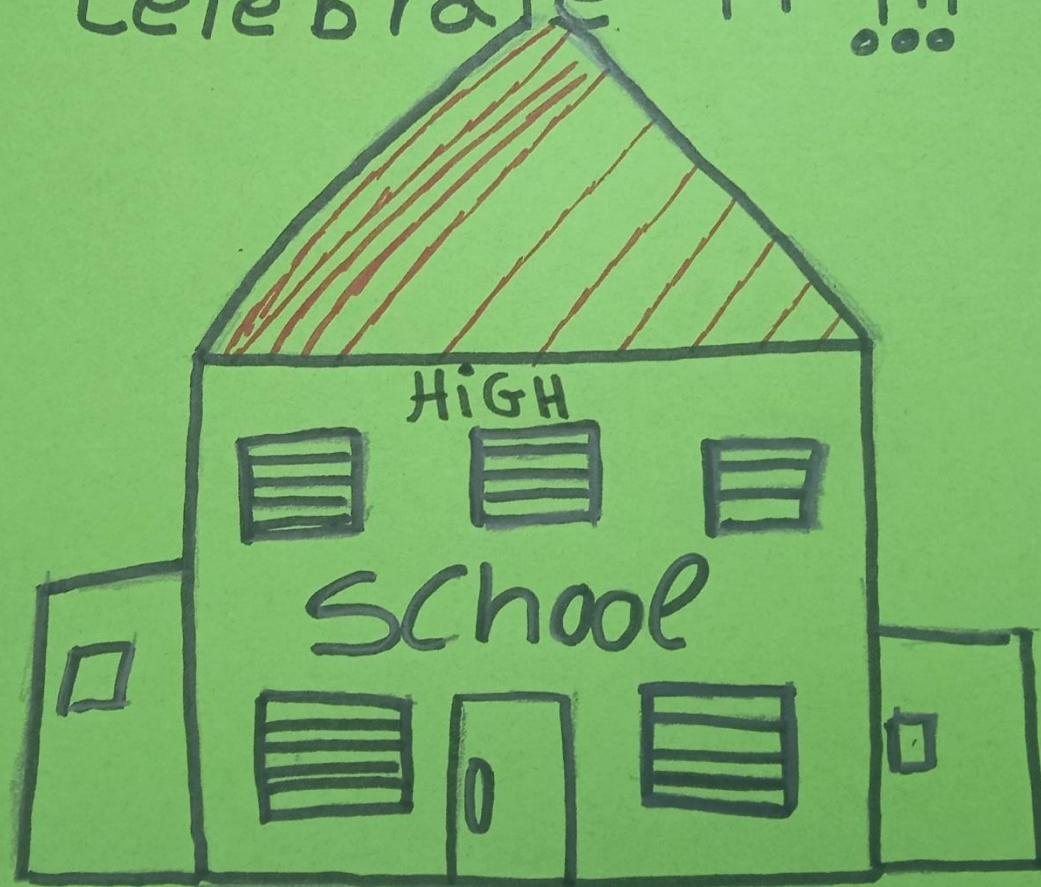

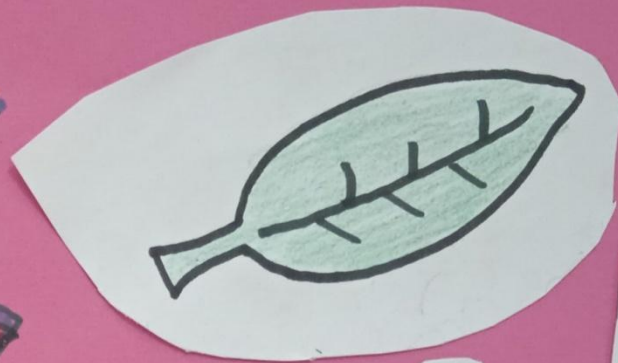
